Dear Student & Parents/Carers,

Please read through the following letter carefully as it includes information for A level/GCSE results day and further information that you may find useful.

Collection of results

On candidate statements of results (results slips) and certificates, grades will be reported in the same way as in previous years, including a grade and your uniform mark score (UMS).

Results will be issued on results days in August as follows:

Date	Time	Qualification type
18/08/2022	8.00am – 11.00am	GCE AS/A2 level and other Level 3 qualifications (BTECs)
25/08/2022	8.30am – 11.00am	GCSE and other Level 1/2 qualifications (BTECs)

Arrangements for results day

Students should come into and exit the school via the playground. We will be running a one-way system, please enter the hall via the first door by the PE entrance sign posted 'IN'. Please do not enter via the canteen.

In the Hall examination results will be on tables, in alphabetical order. Students must sign for their results and will then be directed to meet briefly with a senior member of staff to discuss their future plans and complete some leaving data forms.

If your child cannot collect their results in person they can:

- Your child can write a letter or email to the Exams team (caitlin.comley@bea.e-act.org.uk) giving permission for a nominated person to collect the results on their behalf (please note that the nominated person must produce a form of ID on the day). Please note This request can only come from the student and not from a third person due to the Data Protection Act.


Post-results day support for year 13
